

Charging Policy

Part of the mission of the Food Service Department at Griswold Public Schools is to ensure that all students have the opportunity to receive a balanced and nutritious breakfast and or lunch. An alternate meal will be issued when a child exceeds a negative balance of (3) meals. When that child reaches a negative balance of (1) meal the Café staff will verbally remind student that the money is due on the next school day. When the child reaches a negative balance of (2) meals the student is again reminded to bring in money and a note is generated and put into the appropriate teacher's mailbox to be sent home. When the balance reaches (3) meals the student is reminded to bring in money for the next school day or will receive a Alternate meal.

The Alternate meal consists of a Cheese sandwich, milk and a side dish of Fruit and or vegetable. Due to peanut allergies, we no longer offer peanut butter and jelly as an Alternate meal.

Student accounts will be charged \$.75 per survival meal.
