The SLO will measure one of the Student Outcomes of Griswold 2025 and have at least 2 Indicators of Academic Growth and Development (IAGDs).

One is a standardized IAGD; the other is non-standardized.

When developing IAGDs, include quantitative targets that will demonstrate achievement of the SLO.

Set individual or differentiated growth targets <u>for a large proportion of students</u> that are rigorous, attainable, and **meet** or **exceed** district expectations.

Teachers fill out one online form through MY LEARNING PLAN to describe the goal and the IAGDs.

SLOs are completed by October 15 but may be adjusted midyear.

Teams of teachers and departments of teachers are encouraged to have similar SLOs as they become the basis for PD throughout the year.
